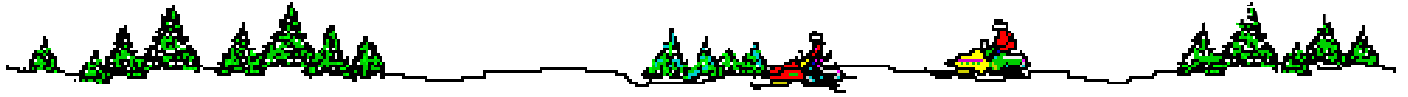

Warm Clothing Drive for Saint Vincent de Paul & Shalom Center

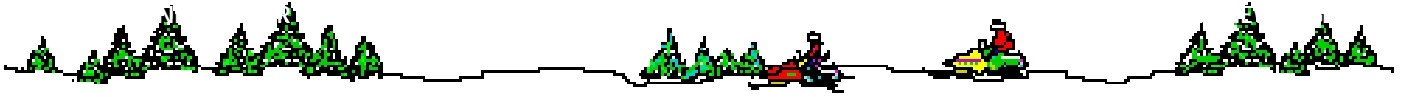

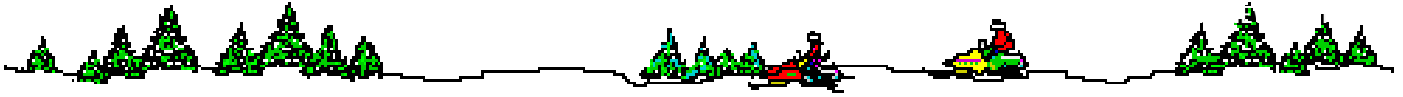
January Youth Club Meeting

Prices on the remaining cottages are as follows:

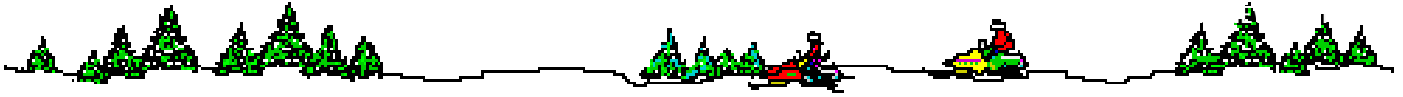
- Cottage 3: Not available/permanently rented to friends
